CONTEST RULES

1. Every child is welcome to participate; however the contest was designed for children in grades 5-8.
2. Between September 1, 2010 and March 31, 2011 you must read 1 million words (up to 10 books totaling 1 million words), books already read during this time period may be included. [e.g., **Harry Potter and the Order of the Phoenix** contains approx 257,000 words.]
3. Your entry form must include a letter from your teacher stating that you are capable of reaching this goal.
4. You must submit a review (not a book report, but a review designed to help others determine whether to read this book) of the book or books read. Books must be read between September 1, 2010 and March 31, 2011.
5. Reviews must be between 100 and 300 words each. Each entry must be accompanied by a Parental Release Form ([On DollsLikeMe.com](http://DollsLikeMe.com)). Entries must be received **NO LATER THAN April 15, 2011.**
